REACH Statement

LEW Techniques is affected by the UK REACH etc. (Amendment) Regulations 2021, and EU Directive No. 1907/2006 on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals. We take care to review our parts against the [UK](#) and [EU](#) REACH Candidate Lists for the presence of any Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) to ensure that information concerning substances in our parts is conveyed effectively. We are committed to fully complying with REACH, and will, to the best of our knowledge, provide customers with materials declarations and accompanying documentation where applicable.

RoHS Statement

LEW Techniques' standalone component parts do not fall into the category of electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) and therefore are not directly in scope of the UK Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2012 or EU Directive 2011/65/EU on RoHS.

The Company does, however, understand that its parts may be located in the supply chains of products subject to RoHS, and therefore will assist its affected customers by reviewing products and providing materials declarations against the [UK](#) and [EU](#) RoHS lists of restricted substances.
